Primary Class

And then, in December, we will be learning about roots. With animals, we will be studying fish and their characteristics.

In Social Studies, we will continue our continent study of North America. We'll learn about the plants and animals found on our home continent, as well as the flags that represent some of the major countries. We'll also learn about the people, food, schools, and buildings that are found in North America.

In Art, we will continue studying Pablo Picasso and his famous style called "cubism". We will have work available for the children to practice using this style. We will also continue with lessons in our Peace curriculum as we learn friendly ways to solve problems that we might face with others. We will also learn about gratitude, focusing on what it means and all that we have to be thankful for.
